	<p>On the morning of the 12.12.80., the sister of the deceased person Shirley DRISCOLL, of [REDACTED] was interviewed at the Parramatta Police Station. She informed us that she thought that her brother's Accountant was a Mr. Niel SMITH, address unknown, telephone No. [REDACTED] who operates somewhere in the Granville area. She stated, that her brother was visiting a Doctor and was being treated for Kidney trouble, she does not know the name of the Doctor, but her mother does. Mrs. DRISCOLL also informed us that a woman named Margaret HOPE, address unknown, telephone No. [REDACTED] was known to her brother and that she maybe of some assistance to us. She also stated that the deceased was friendly with 'Terry SHIELDS' and on occasions he would travel to Penrith, to SHIELDS'S place of business and drink scotch with him. SHIELDS, operates a car business at Penrith and trades under the name of 'Terry Shileds' motors, exact address of these premises not known at this stage of the inquiry. Mrs. DRISCOLL, stated that her brother over the past two months was feed-up with the business and that he thought about selling it for \$100,000.00 'Good Will' and all. Also a youth named [REDACTED] 138 address unknown, telephone No. [REDACTED] a Psychiatrist Nurse, place of employment unknown, frequented the shop and was very friendly with her brother. The deceased in company with his mother on occasions went to a backyard Antique Dealer, somewhere on the way to Wisemans Ferry, address unknown inquiries to made from mother re the address. She also stated that her brother was friendly with the owners of the garage opposite McDonalds takeaway food shop, Parkes St., Parramatta. Mrs. DRISCOLL, stated that on the nights that her brother went out he was always home before 11p.m. she was not aware that he was a homosexual. She further stated, that [REDACTED] NP58, cousin has a Delicatessen Shop, somewhere in the [REDACTED] Auburn area. She also stated that another relative of [REDACTED] NP58's known only as [REDACTED] 146 address unknown phone. [REDACTED] was also friendly with her brother.</p>	<u>TOCHEY AND HAMILTON.</u>
