	<p>On the afternoon of the 8.12.80., [REDACTED] 147, born [REDACTED], of [REDACTED] was again spoken to at the Parramatta Police Station. [REDACTED] 147, admitted to Detective Sergeant McGREGOR and myself that he and the deceased used to masturbate each other, in the shop at 4 Dacey Street, Parramatta. [REDACTED] 147, when first interviewed on the 3.12.80., denied that he and the deceased person ever were engaged in acts of homosexuality. He further stated, that the deceased person frequented the toilets at Market St., Parramatta, Richie Benaud Oval, North Parramatta and Doyle's park, North Parramatta.
