Mrs. YOUSEF also stated that several weeks ago, whilst passing the Antique Shop in question, she saw an old chair and matching stool in the window of the shop. She stated that it was covered in leather and was curved. This is possibly identical to the winged arm or wing back chair referred to R/S 33 33/1 - interview of Raymond Morris HADLEY FESZCZUK
