	<p>At 8.30am on the 13.12.80 saw NP58 at the Parramatta Police Station and he informed me that he does not know any person that fits the description depicted in the Penri fit photograph. He was questioned about the types of motor vehicles that the deceased had owned prior to his death whilst in the company of NP58 and he informed me that during the past 18 months he had purchased a Holden Torana SLR 5000 L34 sedan from 'Holecraft Autos' Church St., Parramatta, then a Mercury Cougar sedan from Bryfields Autos in Parramatta Road and then purchased the Pontiac Grand Prix sedan from the same firm. As well as owning these motor vehicles he had had a Ford station sedan, white in colour with a simulated woodgrain finish on the side of the vehicle. He used this vehicle in conjunction with his business. He also travelled to Melbourne on two occasions with NP58 to look at motor vehicles and each time visited only car yards that sold large American sedans but did not buy any.</p> <p>NP58 also stated that he knew where the person 138 a friend of the deceased, lived. He is alleged to be a male nurse from the Parramatta Psychiatric centre and lives at Northmead. He then directed me to premises which are situated at [redacted] stating that 138 lived at those premises and that he, NP58, had visited the premises with the deceased on one occasion.</p>
