| | <p>On the afternoon of the 15.12.80., NP60 and NP59 NP59, was spoken to at their place of residence at [REDACTED]. They were spoken to in respect of information given to us by Mrs. Shirley DRISCOLL, see DRISCOLL'S R/S, in relation to person owning Delicatessen shop in Auburn area and male person named '146' who was friendly with deceased person. The following information was obtained:- The person that owns the Delicatessen is not related to the NP59 and NP60, but his name is [REDACTED] 1202, who operates from a shop on the Bankstown side of Lidcombe Railway Station, just down from the Hotel and it is further suggested that it is the son of the proprietor '1201' or one of the other boys that was friendly with the deceased person. The man referred to in DRISCOLL'S R/S. as '146' is '146' 146. This person is alleged to have been friendly with the deceased person and on occasions went away with him. This person is described as being Greek and 19 years of age, telephone No. [REDACTED].
