	<p>About 6.00pm 29/12/80, interviewed Gregory James BOLTON, born [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] concerning his knowledge of a girl named [REDACTED]. He informed us that about 6 months ago, he attended the shop of the deceased where he saw a girl about 16-17 old, whom he describes as a 4th or 5th form Schoolgirl about 5/4 tall, olive skin, attractive looking with brown hair in ringlets and he describes, voluptuous, standing behind the counter with the deceased. BOLTON formed the opinion that she resided in the Granville area from the tenure of the conversation with her, but could offer no further information. He thought that this girl may have been called [REDACTED].
