	<p>About 4.15pm on 9/1/81, at Eric's Hair For You Hairdressing Salon, Shop 11 Castle Mall, Old Northern Road, Castle Hill. Telephone 680-2249, spoke to 136, born [redacted] of [redacted], Telephone [redacted]. He is employed at the firstmentioned premises as an apprenticed hairdresser. Has been so employed for just over two years. Not known. It has been alleged that 136 once had a homosexual affair with the deceased BEDSER.</p>	
	<p>He stated that he first met BESER some two years ago through his friend, NP58. He apparently went to School with NP58 and knew that NP58 worked at BEDSER's shop. He stated that he last saw BEDSER about 12 months ago when he assisted him with a delivery of an antique cabinet to an address at Baulkham Hills one Wednesday night for which he received the sum of \$20-00. He added that whilst they were returning to Parramatta in BEDSER's Falcon S/Sdn. BEDSER "put the hard word on him". He thinks the proposition concerned masturbation. He says that he declined his offer as he is not that type and was in fact engaged to be married at that time. 136 states that he later broke that engagement although he is still seeing the girl, who is [redacted] nee [redacted] of [redacted]. He is a divorcee with a 4½ year old child. 136's father is [redacted] who owns a fast food business at 6 Seven Hills Road, Baulkham Hills. 136 was shown the Penry Fit Photograph of the suspect, but suggested that he knew of noone like that.</p>
