	<p>About 5.00pm on 22/1/81, at [redacted] interviewed [redacted] 146, born [redacted] of that address. Unemployed. Not known. He is mentioned by [redacted] 142 R/S 26/46-49.</p> <p>[redacted] 146 states that he met BEDSER through [redacted] NP58. They were attending the same School. [redacted] 146 was then residing at [redacted], where his father conducted a milk bar business. [redacted] 146 had known BEDSER for some three years, and last saw him about 8 months ago, when he called at the [redacted] 146 home.</p> <p>During his association with BEDSER, [redacted] 146 went on two trips with him. One was to Canberra to an alleged auction. They stayed at a Flag Inn some 40 km. out of Canberra. BEDSER indicated a double bed to [redacted] 146 and suggested they both sleep on it. [redacted] 146 refused and warned BEDSER he would beat him up if he tried anything untoward with him. They both returned to Sydney the following day. He also mentions another trip to Katoomba, again staying at a Flag inn. On this occasion, BEDSER purchased a bottle of whiskey which he tried [redacted] 146 to drink without success. They both returned to Sydney the following day. This trip was also on the pretext of attending an auction. BEDSER had visited the [redacted] 146 home on many occasions and was well thought of by the family. [redacted] 146 says that NP58 was a good friend of BEDSER's having received many gifts from him including a T.V. and a watch. He was also supposed to buy [redacted] a car. [redacted] 146 suggests that NP58 and BEDSER parted company because NP58 found out that BEDSER was homosexual. [redacted] 146 says that a [redacted] 144 of [redacted] was also a friend of both NP58 and BEDSER. He says that [redacted] 144's father found out about the relationship. [redacted] 146 says that BEDSER drank whiskey for sexual purposes. ???</p> <p>[redacted] 146 mentioned a Torana SLR 5000 that BEDSER owned. NP58 used to drive this car. It was purchased somewhere from a yard in Parramatta Road.</p>

	<p>NP58 was said to have money at all times at the School, supposedly obtained for work carried out at BEDSER's shop.</p>	
	<p>146 said that he had never been to BEDSER's shop. He was picked up by BEDSER from his home whenever he went out with him. Later in the interview, 146 stated that BEDSER had asked him to go up into the loft above the back room of th4 shop on 4-5 occasions, where he saw several magazines pertaining to body building, but never submitted to any sexual or homosexual acts with the deceased.</p>	
	<p>146 says he first heard of the murder when he saw a T.V. news coverage. He rang NP58 that night and told him of the murder. According to 146, NP58 had a lot of problems with his parents because of his association with BEDSER and the fact that he was always with BEDSER. 146 says that the NP58 family used to work "What are we going to do with this bloke" meaning BEDSER. It seems that one occasion 146 and NP58 were together when BEDSER saw them together. BEDSER expressed disapproval to NP58 that they should associate.</p>	
	<p>146 was questioned about knowledge of the theft of NP58's car. He believes that NP58 arranged for the theft of this car, although NP58 never said that in so many words. 146 says that he hasn't associated with NP58 for about two years. 146 didn't attend the funeral. When asked why not - he says for no particular reason.</p>	
	<p>146 also mentioned that BEDSER, whilst at the 146 home mentioned that he had won the lottery, which he said didn't make any difference to his situation. Mr. 146 Senior asked BEDSER for the loan of \$5,000-00 to complete some extensions. BEDSER declined saying that he wanted to buy an 'Antique' house but should the deal not go through, he would lend the money. This conversation is said to have taken place about 8 months ago.</p>
