	<p>Re R/S 46/5 and R/S 9/3, on 25/1/81, conducted inquiries in Station Street, Lidcombe which is on the Bankstown side of Lidcombe Railway Station concerning a Delicatessen operated by one [redacted] 1202 [redacted] 1202 as mentioned by the [redacted] NP59 and NP60 family.</p>	
	<p>At [redacted], located a Delicatessen Shop which was closed. Made inquiries at a Milk Bar next door at [redacted] [redacted], and there spoke to Peter DALGATOU, who lives [redacted] Telephone [redacted]. He stated that a Greek man named [redacted] 1202 used to own the delicatessen, but had since sold the premises. He stated that he though the persons name was [redacted] 1202 who had two children a daughter aged about 20 and a son named [redacted] 1201 aged about 18 old. He suggested that I speak to the present occupant of the Delicatessen who was at home and living above the shop.</p>	
	<p>A short time later, spoke to the current owner of the Delicatessen, Mr. Warren John KILKEARY, who lives [redacted]. Telephone [redacted]. He stated that he purchased the business from one Peter KONODITISOITS who now lives at [redacted]. Telephone [redacted]. He purchased the business from the abovenamed in July, 1980. KILKEARY stated that KONODITISOITS bought the business from one [redacted] 1202 in January 1980. He was unable to say where [redacted] 1202 was at the present time and had returned an item of mail addressed to [redacted] 1202 to the Lidcombe Post Office some months ago. He did add however, that the property was being handled by Perpetual Trustee Company Limited, 39 Hunter Street, Sydney and produced an old receipt for rent in the names of Mr. [redacted] 1202 and Mrs. [redacted] 1202 dated 28/12/79. He thinks that a Mrs. FERGUSON who runs a hide or skin shop in Parramatta Rd. Homebush may be exectutrix of the estate may know more about [redacted] 1202.</p>
