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| 26/12/80 | <p>TRANSCRIPT OF TAPED CONVERSATION BETWEEN BEDSER AND NP59 AT 4 DARCY STREET, PARRAMATTA</p> <p>Further to R/S 85, interview of Bruce MACDONALD, Solicitor, concerning a cassette tape sent him by the deceased BEDSER. A letter accompanied the tape, which concerned a conversation between BEDSER and NP59 conducted at BEDSER's h shop over money that was owed BEDSER by Mrs. NP59. The tape was subsequently transcribed and the transcript was collected from the Homicide Squad Office on 24/12/80 by Det. FESZCZUK. Set out hereunder is a resume of that transcript.</p> <p>Her visit to the shop of the deceased followed a telephone call to BEDSER the night before. It appears that the deceased fronted NP60 the previous day about the sum of \$220-00 owed him in connection a loan of \$2,900-00 made to NP60 and NP59 for the purchase of 1973 Ford Escort Sedan. Mrs. NP59 was upset that the deceased fronted her husband about the money. NP60 apparently indicated to the deceased that he wasn't prepared to repay same. Mrs. NP59 made reference to a gift to her son NP58 of \$500. BEDSER indicated that he wasn't concerned about that money as it was a gift to NP58. He also indicated that he didn't wish to cause any trouble between NP59 and her husband but he wanted his money back. NP59 mentions a warranty in respect of the car. She states that problems have occurred with the car which are the deceased's responsibility. She also mentions that the deceased taught NP58 to drive and it was the deceased fault that he crashed her car. NP59 then indicates to the deceased that she had proof against the deceased in the form of letters. She also mentions about letters address to NP58 which were received at BEDSER's shop instead of at the family home. These relates to Fines in connection with traffic offences. Mrs. NP59 was getting very upset. BEDSER then tells NP59 that NP58 and another stole jewellery from his safe some 3 years ago. | | <p>the Police. BEDSER states that NP58 is very clever. NP59 says that NP58 kept quiet about BEDSER winning the lottery. BEDSER says that NP58 wanted more and more money from him notwithstanding the gift of \$500-00. NP59 mentions that BEDSER visits the home of I47, who might be I47 or [REDACTED]. She tells him that he's no longer a gentleman. She states that she loves BEDSER like her son, and tells BEDSER to close his mouth to her husband NP60. BEDSER again indicates that he doesn't want to cause any trouble between NP59 and NP60. NP59 then tells BEDSER that she loves him and will never forget him, and that she dreams about him. He won the money and never gave a present to NP61 (daughter) and now he looks for \$200-00 from her. BEDSER then mentions a loan of \$300-00 made to NP59, and indicates that he doesn't give his money away. NP59 suggests that the loan of \$300-00 was over a five months period. She gets very emotional and abuses BEDSER. The shop is then closed. BEDSER tells NP59 to quiet down and tells her that the actual money isn't important, it was the Principle. NP59 indicated that she wouldn't pay the money because of the problems with the car and the warranty. She also mentions a promise made by BEDSER to change NP58's car. Mention is made of a 1978 Model car and the sum of \$2,500-00 and the car. BEDSER again indicates that he simply cant give his money away to people. BEDSER also mentions an item of jewellery he gave to NP58 to sell and if he sold it he could kept the proceeds. He considered this a gift to NP58. NP59 suggests to BEDSER that he should fix NP58's car. BEDSER emtnions writing the cheque for \$2,900-00 which was used to purchase the car in question. This occurred after given NP58 the gift of \$500-00. NP60 apparently indigated to BEDSER that the \$2,900-00 was to be repaid within a couple of weeks. NP59 says that \$1,000-00 was paid followed by \$1,500-00 and then followed by a further \$80-00.</p> | |

| | <p>The balance of the loan was to be repaid in installments by [NP58]. [NP58] told BEDSER that he wasn't going to repay the balance which made BEDSER angry. [NP60] didn't want to talk to BEDSER about the money. [NP59] tells BEBBER not to talk about anything. BEDSER then asked [NP59] about \$300-00 that he had loaned to her for a period of 3 months. [NP59] suggests that the loan was for 5 months. She asked BEDSER why he told her husband about that loan as it was a secret. She suggests that her husband didn't believe BEDSER about this loan in any case. She went to to say that BEDSER had been with [NP58] for some 5 years and that she never saw BEDSER with any other person than [NP58]. BEDSER indicated that [NP58] was always getting money from him, for petrol cigarettes ect and that he always wanted more money. [NP59] says to BEDSER "Before it's too late, don't say anything about the family." She indicated that she refused to pay back the money BEDSER indicates that [NP60] had \$35,000-00/ and why she couldn't get the money from him. [NP59] says that if she asked [NP60] for money he would kill her. She also indicates that [NP60] doesn't like her father, who apparently lives in Greece. BEDSER then says that he should never have become involved with [NP58] the car etc. He again asked [NP59] if she is going to repay the \$300-00. She replies that she will see after 5 months. BEDSER then tells her that he has seen his Solicitor about the matter. [NP59] then tells BEDSER that she has some letters that BEDSER wrote to [NP58] when [NP58] was young. [NP60] has the letters. She says it's big proof, against BEDSER. She also mentions something about speakers that [NP58] brought home and mentions what would happen if the Police found them. BEDSER indicated that he wasn't worried about the speakers. She also mentions about money being paid to a postman concerning these letters that were received by BEDSER on behalf of [NP58]. BEDSER says he paid two fines for [NP58], one of \$80-00 and one of \$60-00/</p> | |

| | <p>There is some discussion over that and then [NP59] suggests that BEDSER has been mixed up with [NP58] for 5 years. BEDSER corrects [NP59] and says that he's only been at his Parramatta Shop for 3 years in September. [NP59] says to BEDSER "Dont say nothing before it's too late" BEDSER indicated that if the matter of the money goes to Court it will cost both of them considerably. [NP59] says that the five months are not up yet. [NP59] asked why that they have to go to Court. They were friends before. [NP60] has the money, but it's a secret. She says that BEDSER still needs the money ever though she gave him teas and lunches. She still sees him in her dreams and she can't forget him. BEDSER then mentions that if his mother knew about all the problems, she would go and see [NP59]. [NP59] says she would like to see BEDSER's mother. [NP59] was concerned that BEDSER should not talk to any of his friends about members of her family. BEDSER indicated that he wouldn't. [NP59] again mentions the name [I47] and that BEDSER is visiting [I47] home. BEDSER indicates that Sam became angry when he refused to give him any more money. [NP59] says that BEDSER is now different after having won money in the lottery. He She also says "You foreget and now you look for trouble." She again says that BEDSER should not say anything about herfamily, and again mentions [I47] place. She also says that BEDSER was the cause of [NP58] not attending School and that she would tell the Court. She then leaves the shop. BEDSER then says "Zena, get me a bloody drink." It is not known as this stage who Zena or Zina is.</p> | |

Quietly and sensibly. They all wise Greek peoples. Oh no, they don't. Specially **Family of NP59** family. Always talk nice. Let's talk common sense this time.

Some people forget all friendly and talk very bad, but me I never I never do that. You did on the telephone last night if I wouldn't have heard Shut your mouth, shut your mouth. yes,

because you talk to **NP60**, I say to close your mouth how can I say that. Don't talk, you understand? How can I say that, I was the gentlest if I speak English I say more nice. You know that. Yes. You know me for 2 years isn't it, you never see me today, you nearly have tea every night with me. What for now you forget everything about, now what I want to talk to you, you listen to me, you ... **NP60** in Parramatta, I can't speak

English you know what I mean. I saw him yesterday. Yesterday when I come, when he come to pick it up for the job he's very upset, he is going to go to the Police. I say I stop here, I got big fight. He want to go to Police to tell all story about, because **NP60**'s very high man, is not man like everybody. **NP60**

doesn't touch any money for everybody, doesn't, you know what family **Family of NP59** is alright, yes, now, what I and I stop here, I say, look **NP60** please, big fight ave a to you, big fight. Why do you want to go to the Police? To tell all story. But you don't go to the Police. The Police have nothing

to do with that. Somebody must do. Solicitor. Solicitors, I don't know. But I do know to fix things and I say to **NP60**, look stay please leave to me, I go to see Johnny and anything happened to this I know where I go. Now, you not have nothing to do with me. I nothing to do. The time when you go to my house, I never talk to nobody about you. Nothing, I forget you, you know.

Yes, I understand. Now, you not have nothing to me. I no want you to talk nothing to **NP60**, nothing to **NP58**, nothing for me. You just forget family **Family of NP59**. You understand?

That's right. Nothing. What for you stop my husband talk? I asked him one question, if he was going to return my money, and he said no. What about you go to return my warranty, I pay \$250

you go to buy my warranty. Johnny you big man, you no want any more trouble. Johnny is not a big man. You are big man, not like guide says. I said to **NP60** yesterday, if I owed you **NP60** \$220 , would you ask me back for it? No. Wouldn't he ask me? I don't know what - If I owed you \$220 would you come and ask me back for it? It's different. No, it's not different, it is just the same. That's why you say to sell me to come up for

and the warrant is good and after today say pay two hundred and quarter of six - But why didn't you say on that - because is more and come in and have a look for price. Johnny look, listen to me, I'm good people and and you know you never see me today. I never asking you after the present you gives **NP58**, you know what present you give to **NP58**, "A lot of them" a lot of them, exact, I gave him \$500 for the car, right? I never say to you after that how many deliveries you drive. But **NP58** wouldn't have expected me to pay for deliveries after giving him \$500 wouldn't he? Doesn't matter, is present. What you mean after present to you enough I call you for work and I no pay you. That's the same thing. It's the same thing Johnny. Your present something is different. I ask you something for three or four months, I asking you when **NP58** go why to Melbourne or something, you know where he go, it was the same day I say to you about something, \$30 or 30 nothing. When I fix you the in my factory and I pay \$5 for the man I just for joke say how much? Oh \$5, I never say to you to give me \$5 for it back because you fix my car too. That's the ... reason. You understand please? I paid it last week. \$28. That's it! That's why I understand you. That's why I never say to you nothing. But the present is different, and the money is different. That was a gift. You right there Madam? O.K. fine. Close the shop now.

Well, I don't go to talk too much. No. Just couple of things. I not want you to tell me anything because I know y who are you and I know who I am and you --you be -- I'm not trying to cause trouble with anybody. I know people sometimes make offend but

is not correct. I never believe it. But anyway, what I want about you. I got girl and boy, I got problems in my family, you not married, you not ... problems. Ive got many problems, Johnny. So have I, now. You understand, you understand, and you understand me, any time you try to talk about money, about everything, about **NP58**, look, I'm only asking for my money that-- I'm entitled to -- ^{don't} you/say nothing. I been asking you about money. I been saying to you about warranty go when I buy or (borrow) two hundred and fifty. Can't you understand me please? I say to you about the warranty, why you promise to send a car and the warranty ... and I pay. I didn't know anything about- the warranty - Cause you like - The warranty was nothing to do with me. Yes, it is to me. It is to me. But that was your responsibility after you bought the car. No, No, you pushing everywhere. I didn't push him. Yes, No, Listen, listen to me. **NP60** doesn't know. If you go to - After you met him to go to the Court, I got a lot of things to tell from the beginning.

First, you you teach my son how to drive the car. In the park. He could drive a car before he met me. Just I want to talk to you and I go, I not want anymore. Yes, right. You teach **NP58** to drive the car. Yes. **NP58** ^{you} after/did teach somebody to drive the car, he ... ^{nighttime} he took/my car I pay. \$400. You blame me for that? Who teach **NP58** to drive? How could you blame ^{me} for smashing, when your son took the car and smashed it up? Oh, you don't teach the car. I'm - He doesn't like to drive in the car. I can't understand the way you think. They are very old pieces they are. Very nice. Very cheap for \$20. \$20 the lot. (customer speaks but can't make out words). Yes, they are very old ~~they are~~. Customer: I didn't know they'd be interested. Yes, well, they date back to about 1890 I think, turn of the century, this sort of thing. Some camera pepple are very interested in them you know. It might be worth while then, I'll give you these back. I'm only interested for the photo, yes, it was like this ... Mum had, Oh I see, and the little child too, so it could be some.....

Yes, that's \$5.00, its quite a nice piece that one. Do you want that one too. Yes. O.K. (cash register rings and wraps things). Yes, I've got one like this at home too. I have.

My mind is for everything, but you open your eyes. You say in the letters you go to the Police, you go to the Cop. I got more, more proofs to go to the Police. You big man and **NP58** is five years with you. I bring **NP58** to the Police and **NP58** comes here. How about when--- and clean the windows. Yes. **NP58** is young. That's right. Listen to me. Second thing. You, Police got **NP58**, I do not to pay the \$80.60, you pay for it, I do not, this is your business, and you say to I pay you \$10, **NP60** doesn't know that and you give all the letters to me. That is better my family, because **NP60** must know everything. It was a secret. I stopped that, I stopped that. Yes, you stop that. He wanted that letter to come here. It is no good. What **NP58** tell you you have to do or fathers and mother, Johnny. Well, he asked me-- and now -- he asked me for a letter to come here. I got too mixed up with them. Too mixed up. Alright. Trying to help him all the time. I know, I understand. But that trying to help is not right sometimes for family, because after I know that, **NP58** never keep trust for all the time. You understand what I mean? You please to understand that I am not bad people. You know me, you eat every day with me. I'm not bad neither. You are. Because you looking for \$200 you are a millionaire and -- I wrote the cheque fout for \$2,900 didn't I? What my husband tell you before to go to pay the car? Johnny don't give 29, you give 27. You come, you give 29, you doesn't take notice with me. Well, you should have told **NP58** don't buy the car. It was him that done it. My husband talk with you, not to **NP58**, you pay the cheque isn't it? I wrote the cheque, yes. See. Who is, who is,--- but there is still \$220 owing. Oh, you try to understand. Boy 16 years does understand nothing, specially **NP58**. But he can be very brainy too at times. Is nothing. He was, Listen **NP59** he was very clever when he took the jewellery out of my safe. When he stole the jewellery out of my safe, him and that boy, he was bloody clever then, wasn't

he? Before three years you mean? Yes, but it doesn't matter if it was ten years ago. Before three years when he was young.-- and I never went to the Police, I never done nothing then. That's right That's why I come, I know. I could have gone to the Police and caused a lot of trouble then, but I did nothing. You know me and **NP60**. Don't tell me about him not being a brain, he was very clever. Yes. But no, very stupid really. Stupid. He was because he got caught. She's know, she's know you win the lottery and keep like that a secret. What for you keep secret **NP60**. Well, that's my bnsiness when I win the lottery isn't it? Not you, I mean for my son. **NP58** keep secret, all for keep secret to father and mother because he love you. After he told me I say, you friend what for you go for nothing. He's millionaire. What for you go? Because he give you \$500 you have to go three months for nothing. Alright, for never, but that is my friend Polatine. But you know my friend Polatine is liar. That's why I'm cranky about. And he asked me--- and I say to **NP58** you are very stupid. You have friend millionaires and you, you---I'm not a millionaire, don't be silly. I know Johnny, I know, I know. You not forget you like before. I no want any money about you, but just, I wan't to explain for couple of things. But **NP58** wanted more and more and more, and that's when I said "no". You never give nothing to **NP58**. Forget the \$500 this square because three and a half months, three and a half months and he go very day. **NP58** doesn't tell you to come to go out. You come. You have come with you for any time welcome What for you forget all that ^{thing} stuff. After you tell me all day **NP59** you do that for me, I done anything to you except you know who need the money if you need the money I give you bloody money. You need ask before and I and I say yes, I go to my book. Now what for you looking for? Before, before its too late I tell you stop talking. I never say special to **NP58** my my-- you win the lottery, to nobody I close my mouth me and my family and never, but you, you say me you no go to his place but you every day there don't get your business, but I-- Millie's alright, there's nothing wrong with her. If I owed anybody 10 cents, I would like to give it back to them and my mind would be at rest---what you think- what you think I don't that? You think I am not like that? Yes, I do. You see. I do. Why I not give you the \$200? I do, you are---- Why, Johnny? Johnny, you are good, you are right, why I don't because what I find then next week. Why I try to warranty.
