	During the course of a taped conversation between the deceased BEDSER and [REDACTED] NP59 the deceased, at the very end of the conversation, refers to a person named Zina. Inquiries made of Mrs. Shirley DRISCOLL, sister of the deceased as to her knowledge of a person by that name associated with BEDSER, she stated that she knew of one that worked at either Katies Dress Shop or I. Steers Auctions Rooms Parramatta.	
	From listening to the tape of the said conversation, it would appear that whoever this person [REDACTED] is, she was probably in the back room of the shop during the course of this conversation. unknowns to Mrs. NP59 ; She may also have been present on other occasions and may be an important source of information concerning BEDSER's dealings.	
	About 3.40pm on 29/12/80 attended Katies Limited, 202 Church Street, Parramatta and spoke to Manager, Mrs. Joan WATTERS of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] Bus. Phone. [REDACTED]. She stated that she had never had any employees by the name of Zina or Tina and suggested that we made inquiries from the Westfield Shoppingtown Branch of the Store. Mrs. WATTERS has been at those premises for the past four years.	
	About 4.00pm on 29/12/80, attended Katies Limited, Shop 341 Westfield Shoppingtown, Parramatta. Phone. [REDACTED] and spoke to Manager, Mrs. CORNWALL. She was unable to assist so far as her shop was concerned, but made further inquiries and stated that a Zina [REDACTED] 170 is employed by Katies at their Mt. Druitt branch.
