[redacted] 142 had no hesitation in agreeing to make a statement.

He is our insured's age + has just completed the HSE.

He claims to be our insured's best friend after going thru school together.

His statement he made is self explanatory + reasonably straight forward + simple.

My only cause of concern with [redacted] 142 came at the end of our conversation when he asked what will happen now - appeared a little more than just inquisitive.

It would appear the next step is for the insured to be re-interviewed by not only the first interview but possibly someone else as well.

Has if still not satisfied maybe the insured's friends
