ANNEXURE TO SUMMONS TO PRODUCE DOCUMENTS

In this Summons:

“document” means the following exhibits associated with the investigation of the death of Walter John Bedser (born 3 September 1933, died 2 December 1980) following an assault at his antique shop in the arcade at 4 Darcy St, Parramatta:

1. Knife located at the scene of the assault;
2. Two samples of blood taken from the body of Mr Bedser;
3. Swab of blood taken for showcase glass at Darcy St, Parramatta;
4. Swab of blood taken from wall behind counter at Darcy St, Parramatta; and
5. Clothing of Mr Bedser removed from his body at the mortuary.
