This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence that I would be prepared, if necessary to give to the Special Commission of Inquiry into LGBTIQ hate crimes (the Inquiry) as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief.

- 1. My name is Amani Ezzat Youssef.
- 2. In December 1980, I was interviewed by police as an eyewitness to the death of Walter John Bedser.
- 3. I have reviewed the records of police interviews with me on 2 December 1980 (Exhibit 28, Tab 40, SCOI.45111) and 13 December 1980 (Exhibit 28, Tab 91, SCOI.45138).
- 4. As far as I am aware, I never provided police with a written statement. Otherwise, to the best of my recollection, those records are accurate. I have nothing further to add to the evidence I gave at that time.
- 5. I do not recall police following up with me after the interviews referred to above.
