On Thursday 15/01/98 Takao ASANO of Addison Street, Kensington was spoken to again regarding his statement of 22/12/97 in relation to the death of ROSE. ASANO occupies the unit directly underneath the deceased's unit.

ASANO stated that he could not supply any further information to that already contained in his statement. He was adamant that it was Sunday (21/12/97) when he heard the sound of a plate smashing from the deceased's unit. He stated that he had worked with his father in a restaurant and knew the sound of a plate being broken and further stated that it something ceramic that had broken. When he heard the noise he looked up in the direction of the deceased's kitchen. He did not hear any other noises come from the deceased's unit over that weekend.

ASANO related that he would often hear noises within the unit complex but could not tell from which unit the noise came from. Although he stated that the front door to his unit is usually open during the day, he did not see anyone go to or leave the deceased's unit during the weekend of the death of ROSE.
