I arrived in Australia on 12th November 1997 and moved into the unit where I presently am. My son owns the unit where I am staying and I have stayed there before for one year in 1994 to 1995 to look after my grand daughter.

4. During the time that I stayed in 1994 I met a man who dressed up like a woman when I was hanging out clothes on the clothes line and doing the washing. The conversation between myself and the man dressed in the woman's clothes was just to say hello to each other. I saw him at least three times during that one year.

5. When I came back to Australia in 1997 I saw the man who was dressed in woman's clothing again. The first time I saw him was on the Saturday just gone (20th). I recognised him form when I was here before and I kenew he lived in the same block. I saw the man who was wearing women's clothing between 1.00pm and 2.00pm when I went down to the back yard to collect the clothing. I had eaten lunch about 12.30pm and then gone to collect the clothes. When I turned my head I saw him walk out of the unit block into the backyard and then in the direction of the driveway toward the road or the front of the block, he did not drive. We said 'hello' to each other and then I never saw him again. He had come out of the block near where the bins are and walked over to the corner where the garages are.

6. The statement has been interpreted from English into Chinese and from Chinese into english by Francis DOU, son of the person making this statement.
