1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.
2. My age is 59 - [REDACTED]/1939.
3. I am a registered Pharmacist in New South Wales and have been for about 35 years. I obtained my Diploma of Pharmacy from the University of Sydney.
4. I have been working at the Doncaster Chemist on [REDACTED] [REDACTED] for about 12 years. I am the proprietor of the Chemist.
5. On the 6th December, 1997 I dispensed the medication known as Androcur. The strength of each tablet was 50 milligrams and there were 100 tablets.
6. Also on the 6th December, 1997 I dispensed the medication known as Progynova. The strength of each tablet was 2 milligrams and there were 56 in the box.
7. On the 13th December, 1997 I dispensed another lot of Progynova. Each tablet strength being 2 milligrams and 56 in

the box.

8. All of this medication was dispensed to David ROSE. The medication known as Androcur is an androgenic which is used to reduce the sex drive and the medication known as Progynova is a female hormone or oestrogen.

9. I had only ever spoken with David ROSE whilst I was working at the Doncaster Chemist. ROSE used to come into the Chemist on most Saturdays to receive his medication.

10. On Saturday the 20th December, 1997 I was working from 9.00am till 1.00pm. I did not dispense any medication to David ROSE this day and cannot recall whether he came into the Chemist or not.

11. On all the times he came to the Chemist when I was working he was dressed as a female and he was always alone.
