The first time I spoke with him was just to say hello and the second time I spoke with him was when he was helping my daughter get off a wall at the front of the units.

I was aware that David ROSE lived in the block of units at 5. number Addison Street, Kensington but I didn't know which unit he lived in.

The last time I saw David ROSE was on Friday the 19th 6. December, 1997. On this day I was going out with my daughter

> and David ROSE was leaving his block of units. He spoke to mainly this time, before walking towards Anzac Parade.

> 7. On Saturday the 20th December, 1997 I can't recall what I did in the morning or early afternoon but about 6.00pm or 7.00pm I went out with my daughter and husband. We were out until between 10.00pm or 11.00pm.

8. When we arrived home I could hear loud music being played from outside. I don't know where the music was coming from but it was very loud. The music at first was either Turkish or Greek. Later it was more 70's style music like pop music. Whilst the music was being played I heard a male voice say, "The fireworks are starting now." They then either said, "Lets get up or lets get off our chairs." I thought that because of the Carols by Candlelight in the city these people may have been going to look at the fireworks.

9. The music was still being played around 12.00am. After this I went to sleep. I woke up around 3.00am or 4.00am but there was no music. During the rest of that morning I didn't hear anything as I was asleep.

10. I didn't know which unit David ROSE lived in until Monday the 22nd December, 1997.
