The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.
- 2. I am 20 years of age. DOB: /1977.
- 3. I came to know a male person by the name of David Rose through working at radio station 2SER in the UTS Building Sydney. I prepare and present a show at that station involving music. I first met David Rose in March 1997. David was the Panel Operation Course Teacher. I found David to be very nice and patient. I only really saw David whilst at 2SER or sometimes on the street. I never socialised with David. I was aware that David would dress in womens clothing when he was working at 2SER.
- 4. The last time I saw David Rose was about two weeks before christmas 1997. That was at 2SER. David seemed a little bit tired and grumpy on that day but was basically his normal self. I am not aware of anything that may have been troubling David Rose. I never saw David involved in any heated arguments or show any fear of being harmed by anybody. Generally, David was well liked at the radio station. I never visited David's home at any stage.

On the 12th of January 1998 I attended Maroubra Police Station and Detective Stirton showed me a photocopy of a note. That note was written by me on the '21/11/97'. That note was written so that myself and Dean DENHAM could get refresher tips on the workings of equipment in the radio studio. Towards the last line of the note I have written the words "We will offer drugs/money/food/sex whatever in exchange!" That comment is made simply as a joke and is not sinister in anyway.

- 6. Sometime just before New Years Eve Dean told me that David Rose had died. When I questioned Dean further he told me David had been murdered. I have no ideas as to anyone who might want to have harmed David in anyway. I didn't know of any enemies that he may have had.
