

TRANSCRIPT OF MESSAGE LEFT BY SANDRA DURWARD ON THE ANSWERING SERVICE OF DONNA DEVITT ON 24/12/97.

Male Person (message recording):

"Hello. You have reached [REDACTED]. We are unable to come to the phone at the moment. If you would like to leave a message please do so after the tone."

(Sound of two beeps)

Female Person (Sandra Durward):

"Ah darling, hi it's me. It's um, god what is it, Wednesday evening, after the funeral. It was really nice to see you both and, and I can't thank you enough for being there. Um, and I really need to have a word with you. I was on my way back on the train and the most hideous realisation struck me. So if you can possibly give me a call tonight, um, on [REDACTED], um. Tomorrow I'll be, well tomorrow it's just going to be impossible for me to be, to be contacted, but I really do need to talk with you, so if, if you can give me a call tonight, great, um, if not, I'll be here till midnight.
