1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.

2. My age is 52 ([REDACTED]/46)

3. On the 10th of January, 1998 I gave a statement to Detective O'REILLY. Further to that statement I am able to say:

4. In paragraph 5 of that statement I refer to a conversation that I had with a person named 'Dee' about 5.00pm on the 20th of December, 1997. I can't remember the exact conversation but I am positive that Dee wanted to speak to Veronica because she thought Veronica may have Dee's young daughter with her.

5. I am not at all sure that Dee told me that Veronica was going to be late or that she was having coffee with friends. When I gave Detective O'REILLY the statement on the 10th of January, 1998 I think I may have gotten part of the conversation I had with Veronica later in the night, confused with conversation I had with Dee at 5.30pm.

6. In paragraphs 13 - 19 of that statement I refer to a conversation I had with 'Veronica' at the Bare Bunnies brothel

The girls who work at Bare Bunnies and The Final Touch are not allowed to drink alcohol or take any drugs while they are working.
