- 1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.
- 2. I am 50 years of age.
- 3. At about 11.05 hours this date Senior Constable THOMPSON and myself attended flat Addison Rd. Kensington re a concern for welfare. On arrival at this location we were informed by Police at the scene that they required us to gain entry to a third floor unit.
- 4. An extension ladder was placed against the rear (southern end) of the units, under the kitchen window. Senior Constable THOMPSON then climbed the ladder and entered through an open window. A short time later Senior Constable THOMPSON requested a Police Officer to attend the front door of the unit. I was also then requested to climb the ladder and assist in locating some keys to open the front door.
- 5. As I climbed through the kitchen window, I noticed a male person lying on his back on the floor with what appeared to be

dried blood around his nasal area. I also saw a phone which was located on a bench in the kitchen area, had the receiver hanging down to the floor. There was also a smashed plate on the kitchen floor. Senior Constable THOMPSON then asked me to try and locate some keys to open the front door which was locked.

- As I left the kitchen area into what appeared to be the loungeroom, I noticed an ironing board tipped on to its side and a television upside down next to it. There also were picture frames on the floor. I then walked along the hallway towards the front door and saw what appeared to be an answering machine upside down on the floor. I then went to the front bedroom area of the unit and located a key wallet on the lounge next to a black bumbag. I informed Senior Constable THOMPSON that I had located some keys and would try the locks. The deadlock and a second lock were opened using the keys obtained.
- The deadlock and the lower lock were in a locked position 7. prior to opening the front door. No items were removed or touched by myself other than the key wallet.
- Constable SIMS then entered the premises and was shown to where the deceased was located. A short time later Senior Constable THOMPSON and I left the premises to resume our duties.
