Maybe I did kill him, I've got to make a phone call, this is my alibi."

13. ASSESSMENT

The matter triaged should proceed to review.

It was indicated that there was a lack of forced entry into the premises which would indicate that the deceased may have known the offender. Sandra DURWARD was identified as the main suspect for the murder and the original OIC believes she is involved but unfortunately, she is deceased. No other persons of interest were identified, and no motive was identified. A review may identify another person of interest for the murder or new lines of enquiry to investigate. As there are a number of exhibits still on hand, a forensic review may be an option. There were fingerprints located that have yet to be identified.
