1. I am aware that if I sign this statement and any part of this statement is untrue to my knowledge I may be liable to punishment. I was born on [REDACTED] 1952.

2. Over the past 4 months I have come to know a person I knew as Wendy WAINE. I know that she was born a male, however, she has undergone a sex change operation. Over the time I have known her she has assumed the lifestyle of a female. When I first met her she was working as an entertainer in a night club, somewhere in Oxford Street. I knew she lived in a flat at [REDACTED] Darlinghurst Road, Darlinghurst. I have seen her at that flat on many occasions over this period. I also go there to do my washing. She lived alone at that flat. I have worked as a prostitute in the Kings Cross area over the past few weeks. I am also aware that Wendy worked as a prostitute and she once showed me an add in a local paper for 'Cindy's Escort Service'.

3. About 9.00pm on Monday, 29th April, 1985 I went to Wendy's flat. I rang the doorbell and saw that the front door was unlocked and the light was on in the living room. I saw the door was open an inch and I looked in and saw that no one was in the living room. I called out but there was no answer. I walked to the front of the building and waited at the front of the building, in the street, for about 10 minutes. Then I went back to the Royal Sovereign Hotel. When I left the hotel about 11.00pm that night I walked back past Wendy's flat. I could see that the door was still open and the gate was in the same position as it was when I left.

4. About 1.20pm on 30 April, 1985 I was walking past Wendy's flat when I saw Police in her flat. I later had a conversation with some Police.

5. I don't know any person who would have any reason to harm Wendy. I last saw Wendy about 2.00pm on Sunday 28 April, 1985
