(1) I am aware that if I sign this statement and any part of this statement is untrue to my knowledge I may be liable to punishment.

(2) My date of birth is the [redacted] 1958.

(3) I am a married man, 27 years of age and I reside at the above address with my mother. I am seperated from my wife who lives at number [redacted] Stanmore with my daughter who is [redacted]. We have been seperated for about 2½ months.

(4) On a Friday night in early April, 1985, about 2.15am, so that would make it Saturday morning I came to Kings Cross with two other people [redacted], my brother who is 17 years of age and I246 who is 16 years of age. I drove them in my motor vehicle [redacted] which is a white Holden Station Wagon.

(5) Prior to going to Kings Cross we had been to St. George Rowers Club. We started there about 10pm. [redacted] and the other bloke came about 12 mid night.

(6) We went to Kings Cross so that one of us could get a girl, by that I mean a prostitute. On arriving in the Kings Cross area we pooled our money and it would have come to \$20 or \$30, I can't remember. We decided that only one bloke could get a girl. We chose who was going to get the girl by the closed fist method of paper, rock and scissors. I won.

(7) We drove up and down William Street, we first drove down William Street towards the City and then back up towards Kings Cross. I then saw the girl that I wanted. She was standing on the left hand side of the road. I stopped the car and the girl came over to the

passenger side of the car. I asked her the price. I think the lowest price was \$30.00 for just straight sex. I think she went through all of the prices for different things but I said to just give me the lowest one. I can't remember the exact conversation.

(8) I got out of the car and followed her to a house that was a short distance down the road. We went inside the house and she took me to an upstairs bedroom. Once inside the room she asked for the money, I can't remember the exact conversation but she said " You've got to pay now " so I gave her \$20 or \$30, I can't remember.

(9) She didn't fully strip just took off her pants and she told me to only take off my bottom half of clothing which I did and we had sex. I paid for this from money from my wallet, that's the last time I saw my wallet. Whilst having sex I placed my trousers on a chair, they were hanging over the chair. My wallet was in the back pocket. A short time later I left the room with her. I didn't check to see if my wallet was there. No other person entered the room whilst I was there.

(10) I walked back up to William Street and my two friends were in the car in William Street, it was parked on the left side of the street. I then got into the car and I drove both [redacted] and [1246] to my place. [1246] stayed the night.

(11) About 5pm today, the 1st of May, 1985 I attended the Darlinghurst Police Station after receiving a phone call. There I spoke with Detective SHORT and he showed me the following property: One registration certificate for my car [redacted], my NSW drivers licence, NRMA membership card, one credit union ticket, one shooters licence and one receipt from Pine & Company and one scaffolders tickets. This along with other property being, one NSW Building Society Automatic teller card and that was contained in a black wallet.

(12) Since losing the property I contacted the Department of Motor Transport and got a duplicate licence. That was on the following Monday. I have noticed that the

cash register imprint on my licence is the 25th of March, 1985. That would mean I attended Kings Cross on the Saturday morning the 23rd of March. I have also renewed my ' Cashcard ' number [redacted] and a Videobiz card number [redacted] I attended the Darlinghurst Police Station and asked if the property was handed in and they didn't ask me for any details so I thought that was it.

(13) When I went with the prostitute in Kings Cross I was sober as I don't drink. I think I would recognize this prostitute if I saw her again. She was mid twenties, about 5'4" tall, medium build, dark hair shoulder length, Australian appearance, fair skin, she was dressed in shorts or something like that. I don't notice her name.

(14) I have not been to Kings Cross since. I don't know any drags queens or trans-sexuals and I have never heard of Wendy WAINE.
