2. My date of birth is the [Redacted] 1952.

3. On Sunday 28th April, 1985, I was at home at [Redacted], Darlinghurst to about midday. After that I went to my friends place at [Redacted], Surry Hills. I was there with them to about 1pm. Then with Maxine and Bob, I went to the Flemington Markets in my car.

4. We were at the markets from after 1pm to about 3.15pm. I then dropped Maxine and Bob off at their place in Surry Hills. I stayed there for about half an hour and then went to [Redacted] and stayed there for another half an hour. I then went back to my place and took the dogs for a walk back to [Redacted]. I again stayed there for a little while and went home with Greg CAMPBELL. We watched television to about 10.30pm. Greg left shortly after and I went to bed during that time my flatmate returned home his name is Ian BALL.

5. During that whole day I did not see Wendy WAYNE nor have I seen her for about three weeks. That's the last time I saw her, at the 'HOLLYWOOD' show at 'PETE'S BEAT' where she was working.

6. I have known Wendy for about three years we used to work together in the Darlinghurst area until about a year ago when I stopped working. During the time I have known her only as Wendy. I have known her to live at Darlinghurst Road for the past four months.

7. I have no knowledge of who killed her or why any person would want to kill her. I certainly did not have anything to do with it.
