1. I am aware that if I sign this statement and any part of this statement is untrue to my knowledge, I may be liable to punishment. My date of birth is [redacted] 1965.

2. I work as a full time prostitute in Premier Lane, East Sydney. I have earned my living that way for about 7 months. Prior to that I was unemployed for about 2 years and before that I worked as a sales assistant, in Brisbane, Queensland.

3. I am presently living with 1234, 1230 in the house at [redacted] East Sydney.

4. I knew Wendy WAINÉ since August, 1984. I met her one night at "Petes Beat", Oxford Street, Darlinghurst. Wendy was in the show there and I applied for a job there and she interviewed me and gave me a job, in the revue.

5. When I started work at "Petes Beat", Wendy and I became very close friends and she helped me get the house I'm in in Bourke Street.

6. At the time Wendy was living at [redacted] Victoria Street, Potts Point. As well as working at "Petes Beat", Wendy was working as a prostitute in Premier Lane, East Sydney.

7. Wendy told me that at the time she was living in a relationship with a Policeman she called David, at her home. Wendy told me that he worked at Darlinghurst Police Station and he must have been in uniform, because she told me she ironed his shirts. I met David once about 6 months ago, at Wendy's unit in Victoria Street, when I was visiting and he called in. At the time he was wearing casual type clothes. I would describe him as a male, about 33 years of age, possibly of Greek or Italian origin, well built, dark short hair but not close cropped. David only stayed about a

minute then left. I wasn't introduced and we didn't say anything to each other and I didn't hear him or Wendy talking.

8. Wendy also told me that David was living partly with her and partly with his mother, who lived somewhere in Liverpool Street, Darlington. Wendy told me that David's mother didn't approve of the relationship, because Wendy was a transsexual.

7. I have seen David once since and that was about 2 months ago. He was at her place in Darlington Road, Darlington. I was visiting and he just walked in - Wendy kept the door open - and they went into the bedroom, so I told her I was going and left. At the time I think he was wearing white overalls.

8. Wendy moved from Victoria Street, Potts Point to a unit in Liverpool Street, Darlington, I think the number was [redacted] I can't remember when she moved there, but I know that David didn't move with her, but I think he was still seeing her.

9. About November, 1984, Wendy moved to her place in Darlington Road, Darlington.

10. All the time since I knew Wendy and when she was with David, she was working on the street and she used to take clients home.

11. The last time I saw Wendy was Sunday morning - 28th April, 1985 - about 3am. Wendy had been in the show at " Petes Beat " with me and after we finished about 3am, Wendy left. I don't think she left with anyone.

12. I declare that no part of this statement is untrue to my knowledge. I know that it may be used in legal proceedings. It accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared if necessary to give in Court as a witness.
