- (1) I am aware that if I sign this statement and any part of this statement is untrue to my knowledge I may be liable to punishment.
- (2) My date of birth is the [redacted] 1953.
- (3) I live at the above mentioned address my flat mate, Mark CHEVOR. I have lived there for a period of 2 years. I have seen the people who live in [redacted] although I do not know them. I don't know how many people live there because there are people coming and going all the time. I have noticed that a lot of the people that go there are trans sexual.
- (4) On Sunday the 28th of April, 1985 I was home through most of the day. I went to the Hare Krishna temple for a couple of hours, actually it was between 4.30 and 8pm. I returned home after being at the temple and I went to bed about 8.30pm.
- (5) About 10pm that same night I was awakened by a very loud bang that came from outside. I can't remember the exact time I just remember that it was about 10pm. I then put a towel around my waist and went outside onto the balcony, it was pouring with rain and I could see nothing unusual outside.
- (6) When I went out onto the balcony I heard screaming and shouting. One person was making a noise like he was in pain, it was a mans voice. The other voice was also a mans voice and it was shouting in a commanding tone. I can't remember what he was saying. the noise was coming from down below my flat. My flat is situated at the front of the block and if you are looking at the flats mine is on the first floor on the right. I remember just hearing two voices.
- (7) I looked over the edge of the balcony to see if I could see anything, like anybody or any shooting but everything seemed quite normal. So then I went back to bed. I got up at 4am the next morning I then got dressed and went to the temple. I don't remember the exact times but I was home most of the day on Monday and home all Monday night. I did'nt hear any other unusual noises.

(8) On last Sunday or Monday, that would be the 28th and 29th of April, 1985, I remember seeing a man dressed in a blue uniform type outfit walk in the main doors as I was walking out. I remember looking at his shoulder badge and I think it was light blue with red and I'm pretty sure it was MSS Security. I am differently sure that it was a security guard. I did'nt look back to see what unit he went to. That would have been between 10 and 12 during the day. I would describe this man as being: 30 to 35 old, 5' 8 or 9" tall, well build by that solid and fit. dark brown hair that was long at the sides and he was wearing a uniform type hat same as the Police and the colour matched his uniform. His skin was fair. I would recognize him again.

(9) I declare that no part of this statement is untrue to my knowledge. I know that it may be used in legal proceedings and it accurately sets out the evidence that I would be prepared to give in evidence if necessary.
