DEATH OF WENDY WAYNE @ BRENNAN.

1. I am aware that if I sign this statement and any part of this statement is untrue to my knowledge I may be liable to punishment.

2. My full name is 1239, I reside at , Darlinghurst. My date of birth is 1964. I am a homosexual and a casual waiter at Pete's beat, Oxford Street and Crown Street, Darlinghurst. I have been working there on a casual basis for about 9 months. Prior to that I attended there socially.

3. About 11 months ago at the time I was attending Pete's Beat Socially I met Wendy WAYNE, at the time she was performing at Pete's Beat. I formed a friendly relationship with Wendy who was in charge of the Social Club at Pete's Beat. When I first met Wendy she was having relationships with a lot of different men, I'm not sure whether they were customers or purely for one night stands.

4. About 10 months ago, I think it was a week night, I was working at Pete's Beat, waiting on tables. There was only myself, Wendy and a couple of other people there that night. At that time Wendy was Managing the place. Wendy received a telephone call after which I had a conversation with her, at that time she appeared really upset. She told me that she had a Policeman as a boyfriend and that he had broken his arm. She had to pick up his car from the Hospital the following day, I'm not sure which Hospital it was. She told me that the Policeman stayed at her place off and on, at that time she was living at Victoria Street, Potts Point. That is the only information she gave me about the Policeman at that time.

5. A short time after this my brother 1240 and I moved into Victoria Street, Wendy had moved into an address in Liverpool Street, Darlinghurst. At Victoria Street my brother and I were living with 1223, a drag queen, 1241 another drag queen. A couple of months after that 1230 drag queen, moved in with us. Over this period of time

I got to know Wendy a lot more .

6. I used to see Wendy everynight at Pete's Beat and sometime at her Plant Shop In Crown Street, Surry Hills, which has recently closed down. I think the shop itself went broke. Then other times we would go around to Wendy's place in [REDACTED] to visit. Wendy was very friendly with 1223 and 1230 and at that time 1223 was living with us. We used to talk with 1223 about Wendy.

7. At that time I was having a sexual relationship with 1223 and we were pretty close. 1223 real name is 1223 On occasions 1223 would talk with me about Wendy and the Policeman she was seeing. At this time my brother and I moved from [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] Potts Point. 1223 told me that Wendy was seeing this Policeman pretty regular and on occasions he stayed at Wendy's place. Wendy was doing a lot of business in Prostitution at that time as well. She told me the Policeman's name was David, I don't know his second name. I forgot to mention shortly before that Wendy herself had told me he worked for Central Police Station.

8. I have no knowledge of any regular relationships Wendy was having apart from the Policeman.

9. About 8 months ago Wendy called a staff meeting at Petes Beat the way the clubs running and bickering within the staff. At the end of the meeting Wendy remarked that she could have criminal name checks done on everyone and in fact had found out that my brother 1240 at one stage was given a \$1,000.00 good behaviour bond and that he shouldn't get too smart. She later told us that she could get these checks done through her Policeman friend.

10. I don't know of anyone that hated Wendy enough to kill her. The last time I saw Wendy alive was Saturday night the 27th of April, 1985, and the early hours of Sunday morning the 28th of April, 1985, at Petes Beat where she was performing in the show. She appeared to be her normal self and in high spirits. The last thing she said to me was to come around on Monday morning to get my pants fixed.

11. About 11.15pm on Monday the 29th of April, 1985, I was walking down Darlinghurst Road, Darlinghurst and I passed Wendy's
