1. I am aware that if I sign this statement and any part of this statement is untrue, to my knowledge, I may be liable to punishment.
2. I am a transexual, born on the [REDACTED]/65, and I work as a prostitute in Premier Lane, Darlinghurst. I have known Wendy Waine for the past four years. She also worked as a prostitute in Premier Lane for as far as I've known for the past two or three years to my knowledge.
3. I work in Premier Lane from each Sunday night to 2.00am on the following Friday morning. I work each night between 7.30pm and 2.00am.
4. On Sunday, 28th April, 1985, I commenced work in Premier Lane at 7.30pm and I continued working until 2.00am on the Monday morning the 29th April, 1985.
5. When I arrived at work on the Sunday evening I saw Wendy Waine in Premier Lane. She was wearing a reddish brown and orange striped top, the stripes going accross. It had a low neck line and she also had on a very short white or cream skirt that stopped just above the crutch line. She was wearing a pair of bikini type panties which were also white or cream. She was wearing a jacket when I first saw her which was either pink or cream. She took this jacket off during the night and she was carrying it through her handbag. She was wearing a pair of cream shoes which were in a type of a sandal style. They had a mini-stillette type heel. She was wearing a black belt on her waist line and another belt loosely slung about her hips.
6. Between clients I saw Wendy until 2.00am on Monday, the 29th April, 1985 when I left Premier Lane and went home.
7. I know that it was Sunday the 28th April, 1985, when I last saw Wendy in Premier Lane. I know this because I never work a Friday or Saturday night. On Saturday, the 27th April, 1985, I attended the Bardewell Park R.S.L. Club with my mother. I left there about 9.30pm and I then went to my home where I stayed until I left
