On either side of the bed there was a bedside table. As I stood at the foot of the bed, the bedside table to the right had a blood smear on the front left side of the table. There were also blood smears on the wall to the left of the table (Southern Wall). In front of this table I saw what appeared to be the body of a deceased female person lying naked on the floor. The body was lying face down and there was a large calibre bullet wound between the shoulder blades and also in the back of the left hand. The legs of the deceased were spread about 1 metre apart and the left arm was outstretched above the head. The right arm was under the right armpit. There were two pools of blood in front of the body, one just above the left hand the other to the right of the first. The second blood pool had a blood smear leading to where the head now was and under the head there was another pool of blood.

The body of the deceased was then identified to me by Mr Patrick Lackey CROWE as that of a friend and employee who he knew as Wendy Wayne BRANNAN.

We then left the unit and arranged for the detectives to attend. A short time later Detective Sergeant Smith attended with other detectives. I had a conversation with Sergeant Smith and told him something. At his request the Ballistics Section was contacted and they arrived a short time later and conducted an examination of the scene.

With Constable Austin I then attended the City Morgue where I identified the body of a deceased male person to the Government Medical Officer Doctor Oettly as that of Wayne BRANNAN. I was also present when Senior Constable BULLIVANT of the Fingerprint Section confirmed by fingerprints the identity of the deceased to Detective Sergeant HAGAN of the Homicide Squad.

I declare that no part of this statement is untrue to my knowledge. I know that it may be used in legal proceedings. It accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in Court as a witness.
