

I SENT 'WENDY'

A PROSTITUTE believes she sent transvestite Wayne "Wendy" Brennan his killer.

"I know Wendy's killer," Pauline, a close friend of the murder victim told me last night.

"He is a sick, perverted maniac who tried to pick me up before I told him about Wendy.

"The last time I saw her alive was when she walked past me with this creep to get to her room."

Brennan, 35, was brutally murdered in his Darlinghurst Rd flat on Monday.

The drag queen entertainer had been shot twice, once between the shoulders and once at the base of his skull.

A post-mortem examination revealed he had been sexually assaulted twice — the second time as he lay dead in a pool of blood.

The grisly murder has sent a wave of panic through the gay community.

Late last night many drag queens and transvestites were missing from the darkened alleys, electing to work from busier streets closer to Kings Cross.

Several transvestites spoken to were furious over the vicious attack and vowed they would seek revenge.

But the best lead police have so far is vital information which Pauline has been able to provide.

She said: "I was walking along Darlinghurst

Rd when I noticed a strange man following me.

"He followed me down to the top of Premier Lane and tried to get my attention but I just kept walking.

"He mumbled something but I told him he knew where I worked and to come down and see me.

"He asked me the pri-

ces and I told him but the impression I got was that he more or less wasn't interested in me, so I told him to see Wendy."

Pauline said the man mumbled a lot and appeared to be affected by drugs.

"When I told him to get lost he went over to Wendy and the last I saw of both of them was when they walked past me to go to her room."
