



MURDERED: Wayne Brennan, better known as Wendy

DRAG QUEEN'S POLICE LOVER!

MURDERED King's Cross transvestite Wayne Brennan — better known as Wendy — had a policeman as a lover.

Pat Crowe, who worked in the same nightclub as Brennan and was one of his close friends, told investigating police about the affair.

Detective Sergeant Keith Smith, of Darlinghurst police, said Crowe had also revealed a prison warder was one of Brennan's clients.

Impersonator

Brennan was killed between Monday, April 29, and noon the next day.

He had worked as a female impersonator at Pete's Beat, an Oxford St

nightclub, and was a known male prostitute.

Brennan had been shot twice with a .45 hand gun.

Sgt Smith said Brennan was last seen alive after 7pm on April 29 sitting in the open doorway of his Darlinghurst Rd flat.

He said police were still baffled by the apparently motiveless murder.

"It is also a murder that few people seem to care about," Sgt Smith said.
