TRANSSEXUAL ATTACKED AND RAPED

SYDNEY: A transsexual, aged 33, was found bashed unconscious in a street in Bondi by a woman who called a taxi and took the victim to Prince of Wales hospi-

The victim of the attack had been walking home on the night of Thursday, May 9, when a man jumped out of a Ford Falcon, grabbed her from behind and dragged her into the car.
She was driven to a street nearby where the

men pushed her into the back seat. On discovering their victim was a transsexual they swore, attempted to choke her and punched her in the face before raping her.

CALL FOR RAILWAY HOARDINGS TO BE USED FOR AIDS EDUCATION

SYDNEY: Government-owned railway advertising hoardings should be used for AIDS education, said Paul Dexter in May. He was answering criticism from Dr Michael Robinson of the Queensland AIDS Task Force that the Gay Army was a radical minority group deliberately sabotaging attempts to combat the spread of AIDS.

Dexter scoffed at Robinson's accusations, pointing to the stance he and the Gay Army had adopted. He went on to attack the Gov-ernment and the Health Department over their lack of positive action to stop the spread the disease, and for their pessimistic

"We're back to the old mentality, back to the closet," he said.

He urged that the government-controlled billboards be used to promote sex with con-doms, sexual hygiene and monogamous relationships.

"This would reach the person who can't take gay newspapers and AIDS pamphlets home or to the workplace," he said.

SYDNEY ENTERTAINER, WENDY WAYNE, MURDERED

SYDNEY: Wayne Kerry Brennan, better known to patrons of Darlinghurst as Wendy Wayne, was murdered in her Kings Cross flat on the night of Sunday, April 28, or the early hours of the following Monday morning.

Wendy's body was found by a friend Kenneth Beckham in her flat in Darlinghurst

A police spokesperson said Wendy had received a sharp blow and had then been shot at close range, once through the back and once through the back of the head. No bullets were found and the murder weapon was not recovered.

Reports that she had been sexually assaulted were not confirmed though speculation was rife as to the identity of the murderer and the reason for the killing

NEW MINISTER ARRIVES FOR VICTORIAN MCC

MELBOURNE: Following a change in Immigration Department policy, Rev Samuel Kader has been able to take up his position as pastor of Metropolitan Community Church (MCC) Melbourne. Under the previous policy, MCC had to be registered as a church under Section 26 of the marriage Act, and this required a demonstrated need to regularly per-form marriages. It was a requirement that excluded MCC, for although it has several heterosexual people in its congregation, it primarily ministers to members of the gay community. The policy was changed following representations made by the leader of the Australian Democrats, Senator Don Chipp.

Rev Jim Dykes, pastor of MCC Sydney, who journeyed to Melbourne to welcome

Reverend Kader said he was very excited by

"He should prove to be a fine addition to the Church's work in Australia and I am pleased he has already plugged into the workings of the Victorian AIDS Council," Rev Dykes said.

Rev Kader is a past chairpersonn of the MCC AIDS Task Force in the United States and has spent a lot of time working with people with AIDS, their lovers and spouses. He is also a registered nurse which will provide additional assistance in this work.

Rev Dykes is also pleased at the change of policy regarding ministers of religion as it will make his own position much easier. Eventually he hoped to take out Australian citizen-ship, he said.

TWO LOVERS KILL DENTIST

SYDNEY: Two gay lovers, Glenn Roberts (22) and Steven Perry (22), were sentenced to life imprisonment in May for the brutal murder of Peter Regan (53) at his Sydney home in September of last year.

On a charge of robbery they were sentenced to 14 years jail with a non-parole period of seven years, to be served concurrently with the life sentence.

Roberts and Perry had gone to Regan's home looking for drugs. Regan had propositioned Roberts and the assault had then taken place. Regan had suffered 12 fractures to the skull.

Counsel for Roberts claimed the young man had resisted a sexual advance from a man older than himself with violence because "he lacked a father figure."
