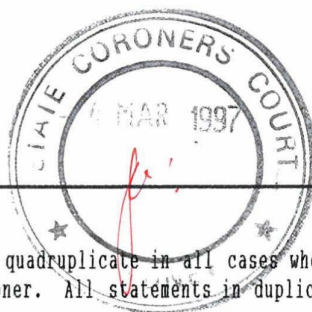

wharf 4, Hickson Road, Darling Harbour. The three persons approached the deceased and Vince MICALLEF checked for signs of pulse. No pulse was detected and ambulance were summonsed and attended at 7.58am. Ambulance personnel examined deceased and no signs of life were evident. Police attended at 8.10am and noted the deceased lying face down fully clothed with his right arm tucked up underneath his chest and his left arm extended down the left side of his body with his palm facing up. Police observed a grave to his left inner wrist and injuries to his face. Police located a black mens wallet in his right back jeans pocket which contained the property mentioned. Detectives and Crime Scene Police attended. At 10.10am the Government Medical Officer, Dr DU FLOU, attended and examined the deceased. His examination estimated the time of death to be between 4am-4pm on 2.3.97. Due to the lack of injuries Dr DU FLOU was of the opinion that the cause of death was suspicious subject to the post mortem being carried out. The body was transported to Sydney Hospital where life was pronounced extinct at 1.40pm by Dr Elizabeth CATHERWOOD. The body was then taken to Glebe Morgue where the body was identified by Wendy WALSH, cousin and the post mortem carried out.
