5. I approached the guys at the bar and I said to them, "You are both intoxicated and you will no longer be served and you will have to leave the premises." The guy leaning against the bar lifted himself up and there was no conversation or argument with them. I could see that they were not happy but they did not argue.

- 6. I then noticed one of our doormen Manni SOLOMONA who was nearby. I said to Manni, "Take these two outside as they are too intoxicated." I then pointed to the two guys. Manni then approached the two guys and tapped them on the shoulder and I walked off as I knew Manni would handle it.
- 7. The guy who was leaning on the bar appeared to be in my opinion extremely intoxicated. His eyes were red and watery and had a vague look about him. I have seen many intoxicated persons in my position in the hotel and I asked both guys to leave because I considered both of them to be extremely intoxicated and in breach of the liquor licensing laws.
