1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.

2. My age is 29

3. I am employed by the Patrick Stevedoring, which is a shipping company. My duties as a plant mechanic include maintenance of forklifts and machinery on the plant. I have been employed here for fourteen years.

4. On Monday the 3rd of March 1997, I started work at 7am at Wharf 6 workshop. I left the workshop about 7.20am with Peter COWAN. We got into the work truck and drove to Wharf 3. As we were driving we were looking for forklifts that may have been about from the night before. If we need the forklifts we check it out and jump on it and take it to where it is needed.

5. There were no forklifts on Wharf 3 at the time, so we then started heading back to wharf six constantly looking for forklifts needed. As we drove coming from Wharf three heading to wharf 4 we drove past the attachments yard. This yard is a fenced off area that contains forklift attachments.
