
1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.

2. My age is 39.


3. About 7.54am on Monday 3 March, 1997 I responded to a person queried deceased at gate 5 Hickson Road Darling Harbour. I arrived at 7.58am and was met by the first aid officer from Patricks The Stevedore. He directed me to a male lying prone on concrete below a seven to eight metre high cliff.

4. I examined the male and I touched the back of his head and neck where there was no apparent injuries as I was careful not to disturb anything at the scene. When I felt the male he was cold to touch with signs of rigour mortis. It was obvious he was deceased and had bleed considerable earlier as evidenced by the blood stains coming from his face running to the right of his head. I could see his right eye was swollen around the right orbit. He was lying prone with the left side of his face to the ground.






5. I asked the first aid officer if he had a blanket to cover the male as he was in public view. The first aid officer got a grey blanket and I placed the blanket over the male. I then contacted my co-ordination centre and requested police and suggested they might want to get scientific police as the male looked to be only 20 to 25 years old and I thought the death would be considered suspicious.

6. Another ambulance arrived and waited on scene and I waited and a uniform police vehicle arrived about 10 minutes later and I spoke to the police. I then left the scene about 8.20am and resumed normal duties.
