9. When preparing this statement, I have referred to notes and photographs from the New South Wales Police Force Forensic Case File Number 4614100 prepared in relation to this matter. During the course of my examination, I took a number of photographs, some of which have been presented, with captions, as part of this brief of evidence. The balance of all unused photographs and documents relating to this matter have been retained in the New South Wales Police Force Forensic Case File Number 4614100 and are available to be viewed or supplied if required.

# **BACKGROUND**

10. On Monday, 31<sup>st</sup> July 2023, I was requested by Inspector Andrew Brady from Sydney Crime Scene Section, Crime Scene Services Branch, to examine exhibit X0000542512 in relation to the matter of Mr Scott Miller. About 11.45am on the same day, I examined exhibit X0000542512 in the Sydney Crime Scene Section Laboratory.

# **EXAMINATION**

- 11. Exhibit X0000542512 was located within a brown exhibit bag and said to contain '1 x specimen jar (sealed) said to contain 'Debris R hand'.' Within the bag was a small specimen jar containing a small 6x4mm irregular pentagonal shaped piece of debris, which I believed to be a rusted piece of metal.
- **12.** I collected two trace DNA swabs, one from each side of the exhibit, which I labelled as side A (XF000536277) and side B (XF000536278). I later arranged for both trace DNA swabs to be conveyed to Forensic and Analytical Science Service (FASS) for analysis (AJ01412354).
- 13. In the process of collecting the trace DNA swabs, I located a very small fibre attached to the piece of debris which dislodged when turning the debris over. The fibre was dark in colour and measured approximately 1mm in length. I photographed and collected the fibre as an exhibit (XF000536279). This fibre remains in the custody of the NSWPF Unsolved Homicide Team.






PHOTOGRAPH: 1 Photograph showing side A of the debris


PHOTOGRAPH: 3 Photograph showing side B of the debris


PHOTOGRAPH: 4 Close photograph showing side B of the debris (fibre visible on bottom edge)
