1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. 2. My age is 72 years.

3. I help my daughter to run a business known as A-Z which is a mixed business at [REDACTED] Belvoir Street, Surry Hills. I have been working here for three years. The hours of business are 7am to 6.30pm or 7pm.

4. On Tuesday 7th March, 1995, about 6am we were setting up the shop for the day. About 6.30am I heard a knock on the front door and I saw Jim knocking on the door. There was no one else with Jim. I walked to the door and opened the door and Jim said,

"I want two packets of Horizons."

I said,

"Yes."

I walked behind the counter and got the two packets of cigarettes. Then I went back to the front door with them and handed the two packets of Horizon to Jim. He said,

"Can you put them in the book?"
