

1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.

2. I am 34 years of age.

3. I have resided at the Northcott Flats for about 17 months. In that time I met a number of the other residents, one of those being Jim MEEK. I met Jim through a guy I was seeing at the Northcott Flats, his name was Tony but now he goes by the name of Darren. Tony first introduced me to Jim, then later on, when I moved into my current flat, with my flat mate Kevin PLUMB, I got to know Jim a little better. Kevin and I have a dog and Jim had two and we would see each other around the Northcott area when we were walking our dogs.

4. The last time I saw Jim was in the morning of Tuesday the 6 March, 1995 (06/03/1995). It was between 7.00am to 7.30am. The dog had woken me up to go outside and I had taken her down the lift and was coming out into the foyer and Jim got out of the other lift with his dogs. I took my dog out onto the grass in front of the entrance to [REDACTED] block and I saw Jim walk in the direction of Ward park with his two dogs.




