3. I am currently employed with the NSW Fire Brigade, Region South as the Zone Commander. I have been working for the NSW Fire Brigade for the past 25 Years.
4. In early July, 1995 I spoke with Detective Sean TONNET from Surry Hills Police Station. He told me certain things. I then made a number of checks through NSW Fire Brigade records concerning the possible attendance by appliances from the NSWFB at the John NORTHCOTT flats, Belvoir Street, Surry Hills on or about the 7th August, 1995.
