1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.

2. I am 58 years of age.

3. On 16 June, 1995 I spoke to Police and made a 3 page statement. I have since remembered that I had phoned **NP214** on several occasions on Friday 10 June, 1995, Saturday 11 June, 1995 and on Sunday 12 June, 1995. The number I phoned was [REDACTED].

4. I can't recall what time I made these phonecalls nor can I recall what the conversations were about apart from just being general conversation. On each occasion the phone was answered by **NP214** I usually call **NP214** on a daily basis just to discuss the events of the day as neither of us are working at the moment and it helps pass the time.

9. The next time I spoke to NP214 was later that evening, I can't recall exactly what time, we had a conversation about a show I was watching on t.v. I was then told that something terrible had happened to someone that NP214 knew who was a good friend of NP215. He didn't go into detail, he stated that the Police had arrived, and that he would talk to me later. I next spoke to him on Tuesday evening. I rang him. He then gave me the details about what had happened to Ken.

10. I had never met Ken before, I didn't know him at all. I didn't know NP215 either until I had met him that morning. My disability has disrupted my work and social life. Physically I can't lift heavy things, I am a lot weaker and because of the operation parts of my spine have been clipped resulting in intense pain from time to time.
