- 6. The sole first went into production in August/September 1993 and is currently in production. To date 160,000 pairs of shoes/boots utilising the "Rock Last" sole have been manufactured and distributed in all Australian states and exported to overseas destinations including New Zealand, Hong Kong, Singapore, and Las Angeles. Of this total number of soles produced, approximately 10% or 16,000 paris are exported to these overseas destinations.
- 7. A size 9 "Rock Last" sole is used to manufacture a size 9 9.5 mens shoe or boot (upper). Approximately 30,000 pairs of size 9 9.5 shoes/boots have been produced, with around 10% of this amount, or 3000 pairs exported to the overseas destinations.
- 8. These shoes/boots are distributed to independent retailers, Mathers Grace Bros, Tailors, Cecil Bros, Public Benefit in Melbourne, Speeds, Williams the Shoemen, Vic Jensens.
