

1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.
2. My age is 27 years
3. On the 8th of December 1995 I supplied a statement to Police detailing my movements on the 10th, 11th and 12th of June 1995 which was the Queens Birthday long weekend.
4. After speaking to friends about that weekend I wish to make an ammendment to my original statement.
5. On Sunday the 11th of June 1995 I left with [I295] and [I295] girlfriend, Lee [REDACTED] to go to Pearl Beach. I don't exactly recall whereabouts Pearl Beach is, but it was about a two hour drive. We left in [I295] car around midday.
6. I stayed at a friends beach house that evening and night. I did not leave the house that night. The beach house is [REDACTED] Pearl Beach. There was a birthday celebration that evening for one of my friends Julie [REDACTED]. I was with [I295]

and Lee all that evening. There was also about fourteen other people at the party.

7. The next morning, Monday the 12th of June 1995 I went to the beach with my friends. 1295, Lee and I came back to Sydney in the afternoon. I can't remember the exact time, but I think it was in the afternoon.

8. The reason I remembered that I was at Pearl Beach on this weekend was because Lee [redacted] keeps a diary and she told 1295. When I spoke to 1295 it jogged my memory.

9. Again I wish to say that I have no knowledge of the murder of Kenneth BRENNAN. Also when I was first interviewed I was asked if I was a member of the gay community but that was not in my original statement. I again wish to say that I am not homosexual and in no way involved with the gay community.
