1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. 2. My age is 28 years.

3. I have been employed as a flight attendant with [REDACTED] for the past six and a half years. About a month ago I replied to an advertisement in either the Capital Q or Star Observer newspaper. The advertisement was for a third male person required for sexual activities with two other male persons. There was a 0055 number for reply.

4. I phoned the 0055 number and I left a message. At the time I stated that my name was **NP194**. I also stated a brief description which was to the effect of, 25 years old, Eurasian, 5'7" tall, good body, after good times, never done three somes before but interested. I then left the phone number of [REDACTED]. This number is to my residence and incorporates a facsimile machine and a phone.

5. I recall this advertisement and my reply to the voice mail box. I never received a return call from any person regarding this.
