1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.

2. My age is 29 years.

3. I reside at the above address by myself. I am employed as a real estate agent with Spencer and Servi, Crown Street, Surry Hills.

4. I think on the Monday before the long weekend (5/6/95), I replied to an advertisement in the Capital Q magazine. The add was in regards for person/s required for homosexual activities. As a result I contacted a 0055 number which was provided in the advertisement. After ringing this number I left a message on a voice mail box. My message was basically to the effect of, 'My name is NP197, call me on [REDACTED], after 5.30pm'. After leaving this message on the voice mail box I never received a reply.

5. About 3pm on Friday the 9 June, 1995 I left Sydney and drove to the pokolbin area near Cessnock alone. I arrived about 5.45pm at [REDACTED] Pokolbin. Also at the premises was my brother Andrew. That night we went to the

Pokolbin area for dinner. I stayed at Pokolbin on the Friday evening and remained in the Pokolbin area until about 9.30am on the Saturday morning. I then drove back to Sydney alone.

6. I then performed my duties in the real estate office and about 5pm on the Saturday evening I attended a birthday party for a friend, Damien ROACH at [REDACTED], Bondi. I stayed there till about 11pm and then I returned home to Darling Point.

7. I awoke about 4.30am on Sunday the 11 June, 1995 and I again drove to the Pokolbin family residence. I arrived there about 6.45am. I then remained at Pokolbin for the rest of the day and that night. I then returned to Sydney on the Monday about 12pm.

8. On Sunday the 11 June, 1995 I was at the family residence all day with my parents and family friends. During the day about 40 to 50 associates of the family called in to the residence.

9. On Thursday the 22 June, 1995 Detective TAYLER showed me a photograph of a male person. (BRENNAN) I do not know this male person and I have never met him.
