On Monday the 19/06/1995, Investigators from the Homicide Unit, M.C.S.S. attended situated at Fullerton Road, Woollahra and conducted a canvass of those units.

The occupant of Number Fullerton Road, Woollahra, a Mrs Natalie LEONOFF, was shown a photograph of Suspect: NP215 She immediatly recognised the photograph and continued to tell me about what she knew. She stated that she had seen the male person - NP215, twice on Sunday the 11/06/1995.

The first time was at 3.00a.m. LEONOFF stated that her girlfriends had dropped her off at her apartment and that she had forgotten her security key to get into the building. She said she saw NP215 standing at the front of the building. They spoke briefly and then LEONOFF commenced making noice to wake her son up so he could let her into the building. She stated that this made NP215 agitated and he became angry towards her. She then gained access to the building and left NP215 outside. NP215 stated to LEONOFF that he was waiting for someone.

The second time she saw **NP215** on the Sunday was at around 8.00p.m. She stated that a man with grey hair, older than **NP215**, a girl, and **NP215** were walking out of the carpark from the western end and were travelling towards the building.

LEONOFF was told that Police wished to speak with her further about what she saw and she stated that that was fine and that she was available any day.

On Tuesday the 20/11/1995 I contacted Mrs LEONOFF to arrange a time to speak to her about what she saw, she said that she was busy that day and on Wednesday and for me to contact her later. I contacted her on Wednesday and we arranged to meet on Thursday the 22/06/1995 at 11.00a.m. at her apartment. At 10.45a.m. on Thursday I contacted Mrs LEONOFF to inform her I was on my way. She stated that her child had suddenly taken ill at school and that she had to cancel the appointment.

On Monday the 26/06/1995, during the morning I made at least 15 attempts to speak with Mrs LEONOFF but the phone was engaged. At about 12.20a.m. Detective MOSS and I attended her unit. There we spoke with her son who stated that Mrs LEONOFF was in bed. Mrs LEONOFF would not speak to us and a message was given to us via NEW SOUTH WALES POLICE
