ISSUE:

Murder of Kenneth Richard BRENNAN at Kings Cross on Sunday, 11 June, 1995.

CURRENT POSITION:

On 5 October, 1995, [NP198] was interviewed in St Kilda, Melbourne. [NP198] produced documentation which proved he caught a V-Rail train from Melbourne to Sydney on 14 June, 1995. Mrs [1289] of [REDACTED] St Kilda was also interviewed and provided police with information that [NP198] was under her care and residing at her residence on the Queens Birthday long weekend of 10, 11 and 12 June, 1995. [NP198] has therefore been eliminated from the enquiry.

One further suspect, [NP202], DOB [REDACTED] 1964, currently serving a sentence at Silverwater Gaol will be interviewed in the near future. [NP202] was nominated for the murder by an informant. [NP202] commenced a sentence one week after 11 June, 1995, however as yet Police have not been able to associate him with the victim in any way.


Police are awaiting reply from the Special Technical Investigation Branch in regards to the existence of a surveillance video of Darlinghurst Road, Kings Cross on 11 & 12 June, 1995. This may show the victim in the company of the offender walking in Darlinghurst Road towards his residence on the evening of the murder.

A mention date at the Glebe Coroners Court has been set for 9 December, 1995, when the Coroner will speak to investigating Police in his chambers about the progress of the enquiry.
