Dear Sir or Madam

I write regarding Ken Brennan who was murdered during the Queen's Birthday holiday weekend of 1995.

I am enquiring whether you have considered the fact that earlier in 1995, a few months before Ken's murder, he stood as

NP218. He was defeated, andNP218retained the positionHowever,NP218is, in my opinion, anunbalanced and vindictive person, who would harbour a grudge<br/>against anyone who tried to usurp position.position.

I am prompted to write this letter because the murder so far remains unsolved. I understand from Ken's partner, **NP215** that there are, or have been, two suspects. Your knowledge of these people may mean that you automatically exclude my suggestion.

However I make the suggestion for the following reasons:

I don't accept, as some have suggested, that the murderer was a person unknown to Ken, whom he picked up on the street for casual sex, and who then turned out to be murderous. I believe Ken was a cautious careful person who would not have acted in this way. I think that the murderer was either known to him or used the name of someone known to him to gain entrance to his flat.

The violence of the murder suggests that it may have been committed, or arranged, by someone who felt great anger towards him and who wanted to "pay him back" for some earlier transaction.

If you wish to investigate this suggestion further I would be happy to talk to you. If possible I would prefer that my name not be used in any public discussion of the matter.
